Conditions Found: One can of cat food - empty - in parking lot in front of this residence. Received no answer at door. Unable to enter rear wooden privacy fenced yard - unable to determine what if any cats or products are there. No cats seen. ** If you are feeding stray cats you must stop immediately; it is illegal and you can be fined. If you claim ownership of these cats there is a leash law and they must stay properly confined to your property at all times unless being leash walked. You must also provide proper care - rabies vaccine, county license, food, water, shelter, etc. The Animal Management Division Animal Control Officer: H. Dale #909 can loan you a humane trap to assist you in removing these cats. **
